After such a positive response to stalls on site last year there will be a limited number of stalls again in 2009. New for 2009 we have added the Junior Hunter Division. A full equitation division at each level with accredited points will be offered, keeping the horse show in line with other recognized USEF/USHJA shows. In recognition of Bunny Coffin, a series of "Bunny Coffin medal classes" will be continued, allowing all riders an opportunity to ride in a medal situation.

The Lake Washington Saddle Club acts in partnership with the State of Washington to support Bridle Trails State Park. However, we still depend on the generosity of people like you, and businesses like yours, to keep Bridle Trails such a special place to walk, run or ride. The Saddle Club is a non-profit organization, which, through its fund raising efforts, like the Spring, and Summer Hunter/ Jumper Shows, provides money for improvements and maintenance of the park.
