Facility: Outdoor sand show arena and two warm-up rings are safe when wet. The park has wonderful riding trails!
PLEASE remember to pick up manure/hay from the parking area when you leave.

Remember – you must work 2 half days at a LWSC dressage or fun show to be eligible for a year-end award. Also Dressage scores will be included in the overall Year End High Point Award this year.
