

**ENGLISH/WESTERN FUN SHOWS 2026**  
**BRIDLE TRAILS STATE PARK, KIRKLAND, WA**  
**SATURDAYS – MAY 23, JULY 18, AUGUST 29**



**DEFINITIONS FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SHOW:**

- Rider Age: Age at the date of the show
- Novice Rider: Any rider who has not won three 1st places in the previous show season at any show.  
\*Novice and Green Horse classes do not count for high point awards.

**PRIZES:**

Rosettes 1st through 8th place

Classes will be split by age if entries warrant.

High Point awards (Grand and Reserve Champions):

- Western Ranch
- Western Performance
- English

**STABLING:**

- Stabling will be available for \$25 per day and must be paid in full at pre-entry. Stalls must be stripped and bedding/manure disposed of in the provided container prior to leaving the showgrounds. Bedding is not provided.
- **If a stall is needed for Friday night – please make prior arrangements with the show manager.**

**ENTRIES:**

- Entries will be through the Ring Radar Software at [www.ringradar.com](http://www.ringradar.com).
- Entries will close at Midnight, the Wednesday before the show.
- Entry Fees are:
  - Office Fee - \$30.00 Pre Entry, \$40.00 Post Entry
  - LWSC Non-Member Fee - \$40.00
  - Token - \$15 (Each token counts as entry into one class. Give token to the Gate Attendant upon entry)
  - \$130 for an all-day pass
- Members must be on the member list or provide proof of membership payment.

**SHOW RULES:**

1. An electronic copy of the Liability and Helmet Waiver Forms must on file prior to your first class.
2. Anyone under 18 years of age must wear an ASTM/SEI-approved equestrian safety helmet. All riders over 18 years of age must wear a helmet or sign a helmet waiver, no exceptions. This includes the warm up arenas.
3. This is a schooling show, show attire is not required. All participants must wear boot with at least 1" heels. No shorts please.
4. The judges' decisions are final. If a judge or staff member decides that an animal is not fit to show, that decision will be final as well.
5. The following may be grounds for disqualification and expulsion without refund:
  - a. Unsportsmanlike conduct or behavior toward horses or humans
  - b. Use of severe bits or training devices
  - c. Unruly or out-of-control horses
  - d. Mistreatment of any horse, as determined by show staff or judges
  - e. Exhibiting a horse that is exhausted, injured or lame
6. Any disputes or problems during the show should be brought to the attention of the show manager.
7. All horses that kick are required to have a RED ribbon attached to the tail that is clearly visible at all times. You will not be marked down in any class for this.
8. Horses should not be tied to any arena fences or any place that would constitute a hazard. Horses may not be tied to trailers or left unattended.
9. Snaffle bits are allowed in both English and Western classes. Any horse, regardless of age, may be ridden with two hands and a ring snaffle or bosal in any of the Western classes. Tack should be discipline appropriate.
10. Park horse trailers in designated trailer parking area. Trailer parking will be limited; trailer with other participants or "drop off and show" if possible.
11. Follow current Washington State Department of Health Covid Recommendations.
12. Keep fire lanes open at all times.
13. No dogs allowed on the show grounds
14. Please lunge in designated areas only.
15. Pick up garbage and place in trash bins.
