Definitions for the purposes of this show:

- Rider Age: Age at the date of the show
- Novice Rider: Any rider who has not won three 1st places in the previous show season at any show.
- Green Horse: Any horse in his first or second year of showing.

Prizes:

- Rosettes 1st through 8th place in all classes
- High Point Awards (Grand and Reserve Champion) in the following divisions:
 - Western Performance
 - Western Ranch
 - o English
 - Saddle Seat
 - o English Thoroughbred Incentive Program (T.I.P.) High Point Award
 - o Western Thoroughbred Incentive Program (T.I.P.) High Point Award

Please note: Awards may be split by age if entries warrant, at the discretion of show management. Special Awards may be offered, again at the discretion of management.

• LWSC Members may compete for year end awards in the above categories. Exhibitors must be members at the time of the show (or may join at the show), and must have served 8 hours of volunteer time over the season.

Stabling:

• Stabling may be available for \$25 per day, and must be paid on the pre-entry form. Stalls must be stripped and bedding/manure disposed of in the provided container prior to leaving the show grounds.

Entries:

- Classes are run on a Token system. Please purchase one Token for each class you wish to enter. Present the Token to the in-gate manager in order to ride in the desired class.
- Entry Fees are \$15 per Token, with an office fee of \$15 (pre-entry) or \$25 the day of the show. Electronic entry
 is available on the LWSC website. Pre entries will close at midnight the Wednesday before the show. Entries
 received after that time will be considered Post Entries.

SHOW RULES:

- An electronic copy of the Liability and Helmet Waiver Forms must on file prior to your first class.
- Anyone under 18 years of age must wear an ASTM/SEIapproved equestrian safety helmet. All riders over 18 years of age must wear a helmet or sign a helmet waiver, no exceptions. This includes the warm up arenas.
- This is a schooling show, show attire is not required. All participants must wear boot with at least 1" heels. No shorts please.
- The judges' decisions are final. If a judge or staff member decides that an animal is not fit to show, that decision will be final as well.
- The following may be grounds for disqualification and expulsion without refund:
 - Unsportsmanlike conduct or behavior toward horses or humans
 - Use of severe bits or training devices
 - c. Unruly or out-of-control horses
 - Mistreatment of any horse, as determined by show staff or judges
 - e. Exhibiting a horse that is exhausted, injured or lame

- Any disputes or problems during the show should be brought to the attention of the show manager.
- All horses that kick are required to have a RED ribbon attached to the tail that is clearly visible at all times. You will not be marked down in any class for this.
- Horses should not be tied to any arena fences or any place that would constitute a hazard. Horses may not be tied to trailers or left unattended.
- Snaffle bits are allowed in both English and Western classes. Any horse, regardless of age, may be ridden with two hands and a ring snaffle or bosal in any of the Western classes. Tack should be discipline-appropriate.
- Park horse trailers in designated trailer parking area.
 Trailer parking will be limited; trailer with other participants or "drop off and show" if possible.
- Spectators must wear masks and follow social distancing guidelines.
- 12. Keep fire lanes open at all times.
- 13. No dogs allowed on the show grounds
- Please lunge in designated areas only.
- Pick up garbage and place in trash bins.
