TOKEN SYSTEM:

Tokens for entry into classes are \$10 per token and may be purchased in advance or on day of show. When you check into a class at the gate, hand your token to the gatekeeper and give them your number before entering the ring. Use your tokens for any class you're eligible to enter. Buy more tokens at the show office throughout the day. Tokens must be used at current show. No refunds for tokens or future use of accumulated tokens. It is your responsibility to be on time for your classes and to ensure that you do not enter any classes that you are not eligible for.

DEFINITIONS FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SHOW:

- Rider Age: Age at the date of the show (July 21, 2018)
- Novice Rider: Any rider who has not won three 1st places in the previous show season at any show.
- Green Horse: Any horse in his first or second year of showing.
*Novice and Green Horse classes do not count for high point awards.

PRIZES:

Rosettes to 1st through 5th places

Seven daily High Point awards:

Western 12 & under Champion; Western 13–17 Champion; Western 18 & over Champion
English 12 & under Champion; English 13–17 Champion; English 18 & over Champion
Thoroughbred Incentive Program (T.I.P.) High Point Award

SHOW RULES:

1. A signed copy of the Liability and Helmet Waiver Forms must be turned in prior to your first class.
2. Anyone under 18 years of age must wear an ASTM/SEI-approved equestrian safety helmet. All riders over 18 years of age must wear a helmet or sign a helmet waiver, no exceptions. This includes the warm up arenas.
3. This is a schooling show, show attire is not required. All participants must wear boot with at least 1" heels. No shorts please.
4. The judges' decisions are final. If a judge or staff member decides that an animal is not fit to show, that decision will be final as well.
5. The following may be grounds for disqualification and expulsion without refund:
 - a. Unsportsmanlike conduct or behavior toward horses or humans
 - b. Use of severe bits or training devices
 - c. Unruly or out-of-control horses
 - d. Mistreatment of any horse, as determined by show staff or judges
 - e. Exhibiting a horse that is exhausted, injured or lame
6. Any disputes or problems during the show should be brought to the attention of the show manager.
7. All horses that kick are required to have a RED ribbon attached to the tail that is clearly visible at ALL times. You will not be marked down in any class for this.
8. Horses should not be tied to any arena fences or any place that would constitute a hazard. Horses may not be left unattended unless they are in stalls.
9. Snaffle bits are allowed in both English and Western classes. Any horse, regardless of age, may be ridden with two hands and a ring snaffle or bosal in any of the Western classes. Tack should be discipline-appropriate.
10. Park horse trailers in designated trailer parking area.
11. Spectator parking in designated area only.
12. Keep fire lanes open at all times.
13. Please lunge in designated areas only.
14. Pick up garbage and place in trash bins
15. Pick up manure around trailer and take it with you..
